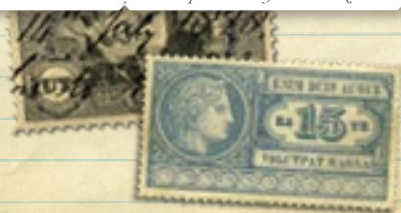

Camp Setup is allowed on Wednesday. This will allow Thursday to be a full day of Rendezvous. We want to emphasize primitive frontier camping. No visible plastics/modern stuff. Hide your coolers and things or cover them with hides or blankets.

Selling and Trading - Those interested in setting up a tent or selling from a blanket in a central location are welcome to do so. Or you can sell/trade from your lodge. This will all be done informally. Everyone will be asked to donate an item for the missions auction as they are led. Remember, there are likely many new members with an interest in basic FCF paraphernalia. Young bucks just getting started come expecting. Old timers like quality things, too.

SCOUT SELECTIONS - National and Territorial scouts will be selected. Each Chapter is responsible to submit the applications for their Chapter's Scout and Assistant Scout by September 1. Use the Scout Nominating Form in the current Officer's Notebook. Include a picture. Selection will use the new skills process.

*** Chapter Presidents need to submit the forms by September 1 or the scout candidate will not be eligible.**

Other Events - There will be other contests, planned and spontaneous. Chapters can sponsor special events or make challenges. Just clear it through the Territorial Rep. on site. There'll be plenty of chances to show off shooting skills. Bring plenty of lead and powder.

Black Powder – Shooter's cards are required for all shooting. Only flintlocks or percussion muzzle loading single shot long guns with open sights allowed. No handguns or modern guns should be brought to camp.

- There will be a pole shoot for chapter teams of 5 people (cut 'er down man).

Archery – Use long bows, self bows, recurves, anything but compounds. Use wooden arrows with field points. Finger release only; no sights. Primitive bows will be graded higher. You may be able to borrow one.

Food and Fellowship – We'll all eat dessert together Friday evening for a dessert potluck before the evening service. This is the time to bring something special to share with old friends and maybe make some new ones. Cook up what yer proud of!

MISSION AUCTION - Everyone is encouraged to bring items for the FCF mission fundraiser auction. We'll have a special project identified for this benefit.

Blacksmithing – Plans are to have a supervised forge area to give young bucks and old timers a chance to see and do some iron work. Any smithy's who want to bring a portable forge and blacksmith coal, you are welcome to demonstrate your trade and teach a young buck.

Firewood/Water - Available courtesy of the Chippewa Chapter at designated sites. Some cutting may be necessary. Camp stoves may be a useful contingency. If it is dry, open fire bans are possible. Good water on site. We will have ice available for purchase to avoid trips to town.

SPECIAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE RENDEZVOUS SITE

We want everyone to be safe and come prepared. This year's Rendezvous site is the **Camp Wilderness in Waupaca WI**. We will be camping primitive style, but showers and restrooms will be available.

The address of the site is: **Hwy EE & E. Waupaca, WI 54981**

747 miles from Minot
592 miles from Kansas City
248 miles from Minneapolis
400 miles from Des Moines
764 Miles from Rapid City
588 Miles from Lincoln

It is accessible by car, horse or canoe (takes a little longer), so plan your route accordingly.

Family and friends can make their own arrangements to camp off site. Only FCF members are allowed to camp on site. Visitation to the rendezvous area will be only during visiting hours. FCF members should plan on staying in the FCF rendezvous area except for special circumstances. Assemblies, except for awards are only for members.

There are special provisions for those Old Timers who need to use CPAP machines. Please make a note on your registration form.

The participant forms for this territorial rendezvous will be signed electronically via DocuSign. You simply click on the URL after the participant form you need to complete and follow the online instructions.

Young Bucks (minors): Parental Consent & Medical Treatment Authorization for Minors (PCA)

Once you click on the URL for Young Bucks, you will see the following instructions:

As the designated Signer, you will receive an email inviting you to fill out the Parental Consent and Medical Treatment Authorization form details for your minor Child. Once completed, you must click the yellow action button FINISH to fully submit the form (with a required CC to the designated Event Coordinator) so your child can get to participate in this RR Explorers FCF Territorial Rendezvous on September 29 - October 3, 2021, in Waupaca, WI.

Once you've electronically signed and submitted the form successfully, you will receive a follow-up DocuSign email confirmation. From this second DocuSign email, please access your fully signed form (attached to it) and print out three copies, of all pages.

- Retain one copy for yourself;
- Give one copy to the local church's Event Leader who will retain it while transporting the group to and from (and during) the Rendezvous; and
- Drop one copy off at the onsite Event Registration upon your Child's arrival. (Note: This can be given to the Event Leader to drop off on your behalf.)

Old-Timers (adults): Assumption of Risk, Release, and Indemnity Agreement (AOR)

Once you click on the URL for Old-Timers, you will see the following instructions:

You will then receive an email invitation to access this electronic form. Please fill out the Assumption of Risk form details along with the Pastoral Certification information. Once completed, you must click the yellow action button FINISH to fully submit the form to solicit your Pastor's approval for you to serve as a local church youth ministry worker at the RR Explorers FCF Territorial Rendezvous on September 29 – October 3, 2021, in Waupaca, WI.

Once signed by your pastor, you will receive a follow-up DocuSign email confirmation. From this second DocuSign email, please access the fully signed form (attached to it), and print out three copies, all pages.

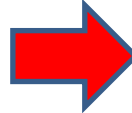
- Retain one for yourself;
- Give one to the local church's Event Leader who will retain it while transporting the group to and from (and during) the Rendezvous; and
- Drop one copy off at the onsite Event Registration upon your arrival.

Participant Forms (continued)

Some quick DocuSign guidelines:

1. Enter the name and email address of your local pastor who can attest that the church has on file a youth worker's screening form for you to be able to attend.
2. Do NOT change the Event Coordinator on the first page. Leave the information as-is.

BEGIN SIGNING

3. If you encounter issues with the DocuSign process, please contact Tim Bouldin for a copy of the DocuSign Instructions for Explorers PCA - or - AOR.

4. Onsite Registration (not recommended):

- a. If you choose to do onsite registration, you will still be required to complete the PCA or AOR (as applicable) via DocuSign prior to your arrival at camp, no exceptions. Due to the remoteness of the event, we can't guarantee cell or internet coverage will be available for those who plan to utilize the DocuSign process at registration.
 - i. IF you absolutely cannot complete the PCA and/or AOR forms via the DocuSign process, you will have to call the event coordinator, and have him fill out the form(s) for you over the phone.
 1. The event coordinator will be required to read to you, word for word, the contents of the 8-page form. Expect for this process to take about 45 minutes per form.
 2. The information needed for this phone call will include the medical history, medications, illnesses, and immunizations for you or your son (minor) you are calling on behalf of.
 3. This will still require an email address for you to receive the completed form(s) so you can print out the required three (3) copies.
 4. If you are completing this as an adult, you will still need your pastor's name and email address for them to sign your form electronically before the form is considered complete.
- b. Note: AOR forms, for adults, are required to be signed by your pastor and thus the DocuSign process being completed prior to your arrival is the most efficient.
- c. Onsite registration will still require a completed registration form, on the previous page, be submitted at registration upon your arrival.
