#### JLTA Participants should return the following by the registration deadline:

- 1) JLTA application
- 2) Permission slip and medical release form
- 3) Registration fee
- 4) If attending FAC, and additional FCF membership form and knife and black power permission form
- 5) If attending MAC, complete the Graduation Application form to receive you saber and white beret.

JLTA Graduation will be held during the Saturday evening service during POW-WOW on June 19<sup>th</sup>. Parents are encouraged to attend and participate in the graduation ceremony. Parents and graduates must arrive at 6:00 pm for special instructions and graduation rehearsal.

If a graduate is participating in the Honor Guard/Instructor Training, he is required to arrive at camp no later than Sunday, June 13<sup>th</sup>, 6 pm. The Instructor Training will begin Sunday evening and continue through the JLTA camp ending on Thursday.

Please pre-registration, otherwise, the cost will increase by \$20. Due to the high cost of ammunition, the **SSAC camp cost is an additional \$20**, and if you wish to use a kayak instead of share a canoe with another participant during CAC, the kayak will cost additional \$20. The camp fees include all your meals, T-Shirts, and Patches. If cost is an issue, please contact Tim Bowman as limited scholarships are available. June 14th - 17th, 2021 "Fully Armed Rangers" Preparing Warriors for Christ ARE YOU FULLY ARMED?

All camps will take place at **Camp Jo-Ota near Clarence**, **Missouri**. Please see map for directions. Are you **READY** for the adventure of your life? Listed below are the camps that are offered this year:

#### **Junior Training Camp (JTC)**

This is the first camp of the academy and must be completed before participating in the other camps. In this camp, you will be taught leadership skills, time management, and teamwork as you camp in patrols. You must be 12 years old and have completed 6<sup>th</sup> Grade as a pre-requisite.

#### Frontiersman Action Camp (FAC)

In this camp, you will live like a Frontiersman and be given the opportunity to become a member of the Frontiersman Camping Fellowship (FCF). Pre-requisites include: Boys must be 12 and older and have completed 6<sup>th</sup> Grade. They must also have earned the Bronze medal of Achievement and have completed the Trail of the Grizzly. In addition, leaders and fathers must have taught the Trail of the Grizzly. Applicants must also complete the attached FCF application and the Knife and Black Powder Permission Forms.

#### **Technology Action Camp (TAC)**

Explore, build, and solve problems in this technology - driven camp. In this camp, you will experiment with electronics, investigate energy and aerodynamics, and stretch your investigative skills. Pre-requisites: Boys must complete JTC. Leaders and fathers can also participate with their boys.

#### **Shooting Sports Action Camp (SSAC)**

Learn firearm safety and expert marksmanship while shooting a number of firearms including rifles, pistols, and shotguns. This will be a fun camp that challenges your steady hands and eagle eyes. Prerequisites: Boys must complete JTC. Leaders and fathers can also participate with their boys.

#### **Missions Action Camp (MAC)**

In this camp, you will learn and experience God's great commission of helping one another. Mingled with swimming, fun and fellowship you will get the chance to experience just what it takes to be a true servant for Christ. This is the fourth and final camp. Pre-requisites: Boys must complete JTC and 2 other camps. This camp is not open to Leaders and fathers.

#### **Honor Guard and JLTA Instructor Training**

If you have graduated with your saber, you are invited to serve on JLTA staff and receive special presentation skill training and how to serve as a Junior Leadership Training Academy Instructor.

#### **Canoe Action Camp (CAC)**

Boys who have completed JTC, leaders and fathers can participate in floating 35 miles while camping 2 nights along the world class Current river while learning and honing your canoeing or kayaking skills. The Canoe Action Camp will run Friday July 23rd, 11:00 am through July 25th, 2:00 pm at Akers Ferry Canoe Rental located at 36869 State Rte K, Salem, MO 65560.
