


Chapters should plan their event and make it exciting and authentic. Some events may have some new variations but will involve the basic frontier skills.

Online registration Only this year! There will be no way to have onsite registration or perform background checks at camp!

Seneca Run - There will be a Seneca Run that promises to challenge you and get your hearts pumping.

Blackpowder – All black powder shooters must have attended an NRA or NMLRA black powder rifle safety course and can show present shooters card. Only flintlocks or percussion muzzle loading single shot long guns with open sights allowed. No handguns or modern guns should be brought to camp.

• There will be a pole shoot for chapter teams of 5 people (cut 'er down man).

Archery – Use long bows, self bows, recurves, anything but compounds. Use wooden arrows with field points. Finger release only; no sights. Primitive bows will be graded higher. You may be able to borrow one.

Food and Fellowship – We'll all eat dessert together Friday evening for a dessert potluck before the evening service. This is the time to bring something special to share with old friends and maybe make some new ones. Cook up what yer proud of!

MISSION AUCTION - Everyone is encouraged to bring items for the FCF mission fundraiser auction. We'll have a special project identified for this benefit.

Blacksmithing – Plans are to have a supervised forge area to give young bucks and old timers a chance to see and do some iron work. Any smithy's who want to bring a portable forge and blacksmith coal, you are welcome to demonstrate your trade and teach a young buck.

Firewood/Water - Available courtesy of the Lewis & Clark Chapter at designated sites. Some cutting may be necessary. Camp stoves may be a useful contingency. If it is dry, open fire bans are possible. Good water on site. We will have ice available for purchase to avoid trips to town.



The address of the site is: 1272 State Highway MM Clarence, MO 63437 - 927 miles from Minot - 14:15 162 miles from Kansas City - 2:30 425 miles from Minneapolis - 6:45 193 miles from Des Moines - 3:20 795 Miles from Rapid City - 11:28 286 Miles from Lincoln - 4:27

It is accessible by car, horse or on foot (takes a little longer), so plan your route accordingly.

Family and friends can make their own arrangements to camp off site. Only FCF members are allowed to camp on site. Visitation to the rendezvous area will be only during visiting hours. FCF members should plan on staying in the FCF rendezvous area except for special circumstances. Assemblies, except for awards are only for members.

There are special provisions for those Old Timers who need to use CPAP machines. Please make a note on you registration form.

PRE-REGISTER BY AUGUST 15, 2023

All registration for territorial rendezvous will be online through AG Convention Service. The participants forms will be sent as links from the registration system to the adult or the parent to complete and sign via DocuSign. However, since all the forms will be sent out through the registration system, the registration system will receive the notification of the signed copies when they are complete.

Young Bucks (minors): Anyone who will be under age 18 as of [insert last day of event]. If you will turn 18 before or during the event, you must register as an adult.

Once you click on the URL for Young Bucks, you will see the following instructions:

As the designated Signer, you will receive an email inviting you to fill out the Parental Consent and Medical Treatment Authorization (PCA) form details for your minor Child. Once completed, you must click the yellow action button **FINISH** to fully submit the form (with a required CC to the designated Event Coordinator) so your child can get to participate in this RR Explorer's FCF Territorial Rendezvous on October 5-8, 2023, in Clarence, MO.

Once you've electronically signed and submitted the form successfully, you will receive a follow-up DocuSign email confirmation. From this second DocuSign email, please access your fully signed form (attached to it) and



Once you've electronically signed and submitted the form successfully, you will receive a follow-up DocuSign email confirmation. From this second DocuSign email, please access your fully signed form (attached to it) and print out one copy of all pages.

- Retain an electronic copy for yourself.
- Give one to the local church's Event Leader who will retain it while transporting the group to and from (and during) the Rendezvous.
- This registration is conditional on completing and passing step 2.

Step 2: Background Check

Once the AOR is complete, you will receive an email from Trusted Employee (see sample). This is our background check company. The sample is provided so you will know this is a legitimate email. Please don't be concerned about the credit check verbiage. We are not checking your credit. Trusted Employee has to have that verbiage whether or not the credit check is being run.

The timing of this email will be within a week and half to two weeks after you register online. We will only pull new registration once a week until about three prior to the event. Then, we will pull new registration every day. It is extremely important that you take the five minutes to complete this form immediately.

This system will ask for personal information, such as name, address, SSN, etc. It will also ask what position you are applying for. Remember, this is who we use for employee background checks. For position, list **Territorial Rendezvous**.

Vendors (onsite): All vendors staying onsite at the territorial rendezvous will have to complete the entire adult registration and approval process, including the background check.

Vendors (offsite): All vendors staying offsite for the territorial rendezvous will only be permitted to enter the event 30 minutes prior to visiting hours and will need to leave the event area 30 minutes after visiting hours.

Onsite Registration: There will be <u>**no</u>** onsite registration because we will not be able to run a background on attendees onsite.</u>
